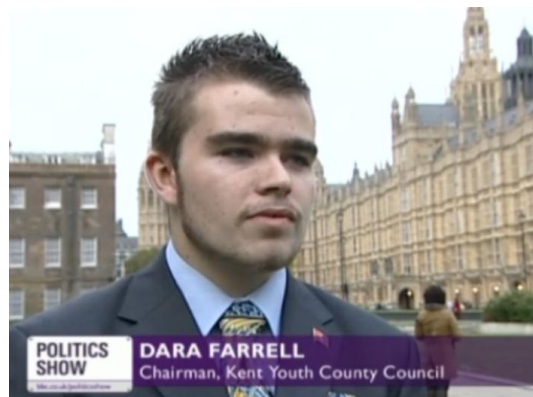


Dara Farrell
