Who can be nominated for an award:

Any organisation or project that works with young people in the UK.

Criteria for the award:

You'll need to demonstrate how an innovation has met at least THREE of these criteria:

- Increased an organisation's ability to work with young people and support youth participation in decision-making
- Enabled young people to make a significant positive contribution at a local, national or international level
- Allowed young peoples' creativity to shine
- Inspired, empowered and encouraged the involvement of young people from a range of backgrounds.
- Increased youth leadership and given young people a voice in how the organisation is run

The process:

Nominations from young people themselves are especially welcome.

Judging will be exclusively by a panel of elected young people.

Successful award holders will be given a dated certificate, and projects and organisations will be allowed to use a 'Youth on Board' logo. Individuals will be awarded an exclusive British Youth Council pin badges. All award holders will be listed on www.byc.org.uk
