Mark the achievements of an individual young person who has made a real difference through their role in the running of an organisation or project – this may be through a charity board, youth forum, executive or committee. Recognise the sustained effort, creativity, leadership, and teamwork of young people.

Who can be nominated for an award:

Young individuals need to be nominated for a Make a Difference award by:

- a support or youth worker
- other members of their Board, forum, committee etc
- young people or other people who benefit from their work

The young people should be aged 25 and under and should have contributed in their current role for a minimum of 6 months.

Criteria for the award:

You'll need to demonstrate how the individual has met at least THREE of these criteria by:

- Making a positive impact to the running of an organisation or project.
- Contributing to an organisation or project over a period of time (minimum of six months).
- Inspiring others.
- Being inclusive to others and allowing others to have their say.

The process:

Nominations from young people themselves are especially welcome.

Judging will be exclusively by a panel of elected young people.

Successful award holders will be given a dated certificate, and projects and organisations will be allowed to use a 'Youth on Board' logo. Individuals will be awarded an exclusive British Youth Council pin badges. All award holders will be listed on www.byc.org.uk
